

WHAT ARE YOU THINKING? PART 4

Part 1 — The relationship between “thinking” and “instruction”

A reminder of where we left off:

Jer 4:14 “O Yerushalayim, wash your heart from evil, and be saved. Till when would your wicked **thoughts** remain within you?”

- The Hebrew for “wicked” can also mean vain effort or exertion that ends in nothingness or trouble

Jer 6:1-19

Jer 6:19 “Hear O earth! See, I am bringing evil upon this people, even the fruit of their **thoughts**, because they have not listened to My words, nor My Torah – and they rejected it.”

Let’s continue now in **Deut 4:25-40**

- **Deut 4:36** – From the heavens He let you hear His voice, to instruct you...
 - **Jer 6:8** – Be instructed, O Yerushalayim, lest My being be torn from you...

Isa 65:1-7

“I have held out My hands all day long to a stubborn people, who walk in a way that is not good, after their own **thoughts;**”
