

ARE YOU SAVED? – 2018 – PART 2

THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN SALVATION, FAITH AND WORKS

Part 1 – The 4 Cups

- **Exo 6:1-8** The “4 Cups” – Sanctification, Deliverance, Redemption, Acceptance
 - **The Cup of Deliverance**
 - **He delivers us** from our being enslaved...
 - This may be the moment when you first see yourself as **“SAVED”**
 - Once **“SAVED,”** delivered from your burdens, you still need to be delivered from the enslaving of the world’s ways, SIN, to the freedom found in walking according Yah’s ways, the path of Torah
 - **Rom 6:16** – we are servants of the one who we obey...
 - **James 1:25**
 - **Eph 2:1-5**
 - He delivers us so we can see His love, compassion and mercy
 - He delivers us so we can see the **TRUTH**
 - **John 8:31-36, John 14:6, Psa 119:142, 160, John 1:14**
 - There are 2 aspects of deliverance
 - Deliverance from the spiritual bondage of paganism
 - Deliverance from the physical bondage of slavery
 - The Exodus account shows that we are delivered from spiritual bondage first, then from the physical bondage
 - **The Cup of Redemption**
 - **He redeems us** with an outstretched arm and great judgments...
 - We are redeemed by the death, burial and resurrection of Yeshua, the outstretched arm of Elohim
 - **1 Cor 6:19-20** “you are not your own, you were bought with a price”



- **The Cup of Acceptance**
 - **He takes us as His people** and shall be our Elohim...
 - He will take us as His people through the same process as ancient Israel – the Covenant as expressed at Sinai
 - **Exo 19:5-8** and **Deut 26:16-19**
 - **He brings us into the “LAND”**
 - He shows us the WAY to the Kingdom

Part 2 – Once saved always saved...Really?
