Intro – Clarify what was said in Part 1 & 2

- Review Mat 11:25-27 from Part 1
- Eyes to see, Ears to hear, hearts to receive
- No one has seen the Father or heard His voice at anytime
- We have to be careful what we are using as the base and what we are trying to make fit into the base – Explain and give examples

Yohanan 14:1-12 “If you had known Me, you would have known My Father too...”

- ginosko (ghin-ocē'-ko) to "know" absolutely; learn to know, come to know, get a knowledge of; perceive, have knowledge of.

Yohanan 15:20-21 They (Judah) persecuted Yahshua because they did not know the Father

Yohanan 7:25-30

²⁸ Yeshua therefore cried out in the Set- apart Place, teaching and saying, “You both know Me, and you know where I am from. And I have not come of Myself, but He who sent Me is true, whom you do not know.

²⁹ “But I know Him, because I am from Him, and He sent Me.”

Yohanan 8:12-59

¹² “I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall by no means walk in darkness, but possess (have, lay hold of) the light of life.”

¹⁸ “I am One who witnesses concerning Myself, and the Father who sent Me witnesses concerning Me.”

¹⁹ Therefore they said to Him, “Where is Your Father?” Yeshua answered, “You know neither Me nor My Father. If you knew Me, you would have known My Father also.”
