

TO HE WHO OVERCOMES - PART 3

We are children of promise

- Gal 4:28 – ...and we...as Yitzchak was, are children of promise
- Rom 7:18 to 8:18 – ...we are the children of Elohim...and co-heirs...
- Gal 3:26-29 – if you are of Messiah then you are seed of Avraham, and heirs according to promise
 - Gen 12:3 – Kol Mishpachot – All the families
 - Gen 17:5 – Hamon Goyim – Hamon = crowd, mob, tumult, noise

In Messiah there is only 1 people Yisrael. We need to overcome our seeing ourselves as Yehudite or Goyim. Once you become a citizen of the nation of Yisrael what you were before doesn't matter.

- Deut 23:3 – ...an Ammonite or Mo'abite does not enter the assembly of Yahweh...
- Ruth 2:2 – ...and Ruth the Mo'abite, said to Na'omi...
- Ruth 1:16 – ...your people are my people, and your Elohim is my Elohim
- Mat 1:5 – ...and Boaz brought forth Oved by Ruth...
- Exo 12:37-38 – ...the children of Yisrael set out...and a mixed multitude
 - Yet when they crossed the Yarden they were all Yisrael

Those coming from a Jewish background have to overcome:

- their belief that Moshiach has not yet come
- their focus on the fences around the Torah instead of on the Torah itself – Mark 7:1-5
- their feelings for the returning lost Israelites (see the prodigal son parable) Luke 15:11-32

Those coming from the Nations / Goyim / Lost Israelites have to overcome:

- For the Goyim - their pagan Babylonian lifestyles and traditions
- For the lost Israelites - their resistance to belief in their Hebraic heritage and true identity
- For both - their belief that the Torah has been done away with
