

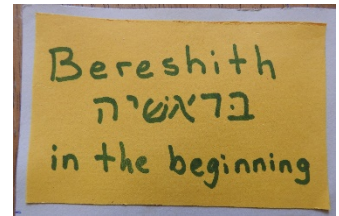
PRECIOUS POSSESSIONS

Notebook Page - page 2:

Instructions for the notebook page:

Section 1:

- Using any color of construction paper or card stock, cut a 4" (10 cm) by 2½" (6¼ cm) rectangle.
- Write the Hebrew word:
 - 1) "Bereshith"
 - 2) "בראשית"
 - 3) "In the beginning"
- Glue the rectangle in section 1 at the upper left corner of the page.



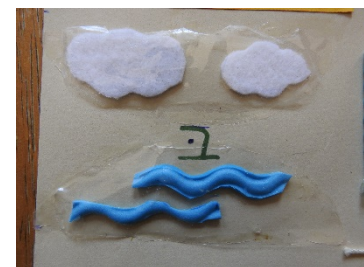
Section 2:

- Put black and yellow construction paper together and cut out 2 misshapen circles. Be sure to cut them at the same time so that they fit exactly on top of each other, with the black on top.
- On the yellow shape, write an aleph 'א' in the center.
- Poke a hole at the top center of the shapes to insert a brad, but do NOT open the back of the brad yet.
- Poke a hole at the top of the center of section 2 (right top corner) of the page.
- Insert the brad with shapes attached and open at the back. The first day is finished and dark and light can be separated, day and night.



Section 3:

- Using clear cellophane or plastic, cut 2 half circles about 4" (10 cm) by 1" (2½ cm) to 1½" (3¾ cm).
- Cut 2 small cloud shapes using any of the following: white cotton balls, batting, felt or fleece.
- Cut blue waves from construction paper, fun foam or card stock. Optional: make waves with puffy paint.
- Glue clouds on the upper part of section 3 and the waves on the bottom of section 3.
- Write the Hebrew letter bet 'ב' between the clouds and the waves.
- Glue semi circles of clear plastic over the clouds and the waves with arcs facing each other.



Day 2 is finished.

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Notebook Page - page 3:

Instructions for the notebook page cont'd:

Section 4:

- Cut a 4" (10 cm) by 2½" (6¼ cm) rectangle for water out of blue fun foam, construction paper or card stock.
- Cut a 3" (7½ cm) by 1½" (3¾ cm) semi circle for land out of sandpaper, or construction paper.
- Cut a 3" (7½ cm) by ½" (1¼ cm) strip of green tissue paper or construction paper and fringe it by making small cuts for grass.
- Cut a small brown tree trunk shape out of construction paper.
- Glue land on section 4.
- Glue the tree trunk and grass around the land as shown.
- Using a small piece of green tissue paper, crumple it and glue it to the top of the tree trunk.
- Glue different color pieces of tissue paper for flowers on the land.
- On the tree trunk, write the letter gimel 'ג'.
- If using paper to represent water, fold a small section on the short end of the blue rectangle and glue to the left side of section 4.
- If using fun foam, the short end may need to be scored (a cut on one side but NOT all the way through the foam) so that it will bend and hot glue it to the left side of section 4.



Day 3 is finished. The water can be pulled back from the land.



Section 5:

- Using blue construction paper, fun foam or card stock, cut a 2" (5 cm) diameter circle.
- Using green construction paper, card stock or fun foam, cut a land mass to fit circle.
- Glue the green land mass on the circle to represent the earth.
- Poke a hole in center of the earth and place brad in the hole but do NOT open it yet.
- Write the letter dalet 'ד' on the center of the earth, around the brad.



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Notebook Page - page 4:

Instructions for the notebook page cont'd:

Section 5 cont'd:

- Poke a hole in the center of section 5 and push the brad with the earth attached through the hole.
- Open the brad in the back.
- Glue the gold circle sequin to represent the sun on the left upper side of section 5.
- Glue the silver sequin (cut sequin in a half circle) or item being used to represent moon on opposite side of the earth from the sun. Optional: glue some foil stars as well.

Day 4 is finished. The earth can be spun.

Section 6:

- Cut sea creatures out of foam, construction paper, card stock using the template provided or create your own. Optional: print them from the web or use stickers.
- Do the same for flying creatures no bigger than 1" ($2\frac{1}{2}$ cm).
- Using cellophane or plastic cut a rectangle piece 4" (10 cm) by 1" ($2\frac{1}{2}$ cm).
- Cut a small quarter circle (about 1" ($2\frac{1}{2}$ cm) long) out of brown paper.
- Cut 1 length of string or twine 4" (10 cm), then cut 2 or 3 lengths of string 2" (5 cm) long.
- Glue the sea creatures to the bottom half of section 6.
- Glue the cellophane over the sea creatures.
- Glue the small brown quarter circle on the right side just above the cellophane to make an island.
- Write the letter hey 'ה' above the island in green or brown.
- Hot glue the small string lengths to the back of the flying creatures creating a loop.
- Slide the loops onto the 4" (10 cm) string and then hot glue each end of the string at the top of section 6. The flying creatures should be able to slide across the string as if they are flying.

Instructions for the notebook page cont'd:

Section 7:

- Make a land mass about 4" (10 cm) long out of sandpaper, moss, fun foam or paper.
- Cut Adam and Hawwah from black construction paper using Notebook Template A.
- Use different textured materials to create animals; for example use cotton balls or other white material to make 2 sheep. For additional animals, make sure there are 2 of each.
- Glue the land mass to the bottom of section 7; then, create your garden with the animals and Adam and Hawwah.
- Write the letter vav 'v' next to Adam and Hawwah as a covering.

Day 6 is finished.

Section 8:

- Print and color the picture of Adam and Hawwah worshipping Yahweh.
- Cut it out to fit section 8.
- Glue it to the last section and explain that Adam and Hawwah are resting and worshipping Yahweh on the seventh day which is Shabbat.

Day 7 is finished.
