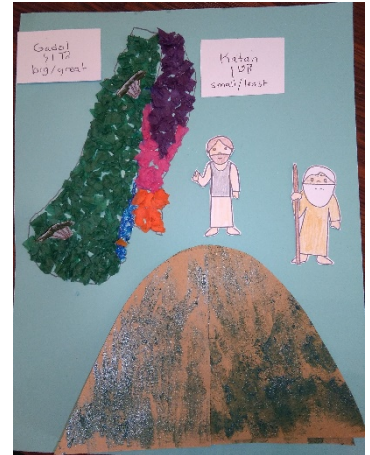


PRECIOUS POSSESSIONS

Notebook Page Instructions Mosheh Transfers Leadership Deuteronomy 1:27-28

Materials:

- Card stock - light green, white & brown
- Crayons, pencils or markers
- Tacky Glue
- Repositionable glue
- Scissors
- Tissue paper
- Dimensional paint - blue
- Paint - green
- Sponge brush
- Cups for water and paint
- Small amounts of green tissue paper along with 3 other colors of choice
- Optional: pieces of fake branches
- Notebook Templates: Main Page and Template B



Note: there will be no video for this week's Notebook Page.

Parent/Teacher preparation:

- Print Main Page on light green card stock.
- Print Notebook Template B on white card stock.

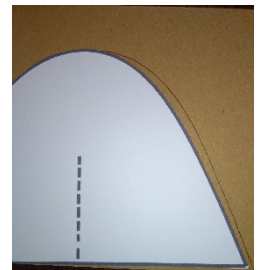
Instructions for the notebook page:

- Using blue dimensional paint, outline and fill the Yarden River.
- Set aside to dry.
- Color Mosheh, Yehoshua and the trunks of the palm trees on Notebook Template B.
- Cut out all the pieces from Notebook Template B. Do NOT cut on the dotted line.



Creating the stand up mountain

- Fold the brown card stock in half width wise.
- Use the mountain template and trace it onto the brown card stock.
- Cut the traced mountain out, making sure to keep the paper folded so you get 2 pieces.

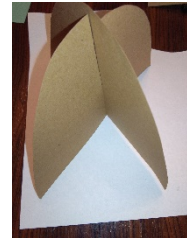

Notebook Page - page 2:

Instructions for the notebook page:

- Separate the 2 mountain pieces and put the pattern on top of one of the mountain pieces, then cut through the dotted line on both pieces.
- Measure and draw a line $2\frac{1}{4}$ " ($5\frac{3}{4}$ cm) from the tip of the other mountain piece.
- Cut on the line you just drew.
- The mountain pieces should be able to go together using the 2 slits.
- Test them out then pull them back apart.
- Put some green paint in the paint cup and using the sponge brush, dry brush green on the mountain pieces.
- Set them aside to dry.
- Once dried, paint the other side and set aside.



Mosheh and Yehoshua

- Glue front to back of both characters.
- Put some repositionable glue on the back of the legs of both characters.
- Set aside for glue to dry.



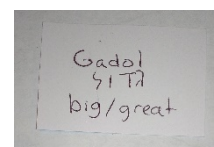
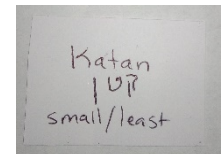
Palm trees

- Cut small pieces of the branch and glue them to the tops of the palm trees.
- Set aside to dry.



Main Page

- Check to make sure the paint is dry on the Main Page. If it is, begin filling the land pieces with small balls of tissue paper.
- Cut 2 small rectangles for the Hebrew words. Write the words:
1) "Katan" 2) "קטן" 3) "Small/least"
1) "Gadol" 2) "גדול" 3) "Big/great"

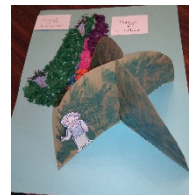

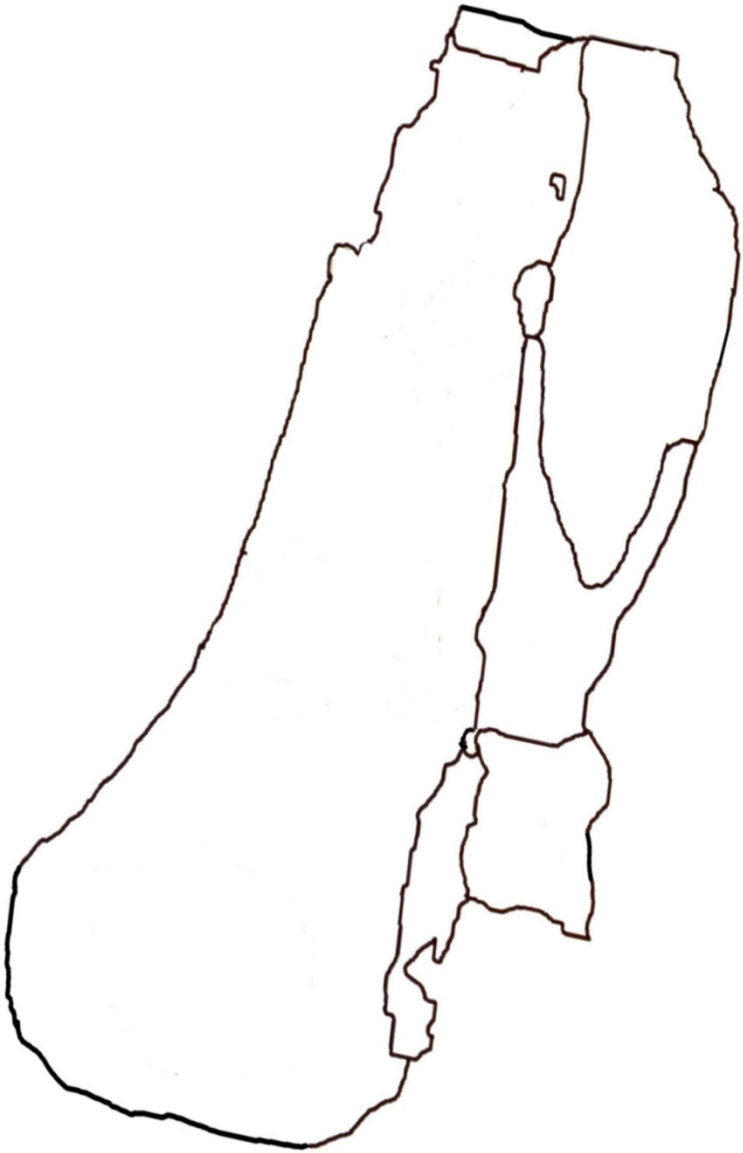
Instructions for the notebook page cont'd:

Assembling the page

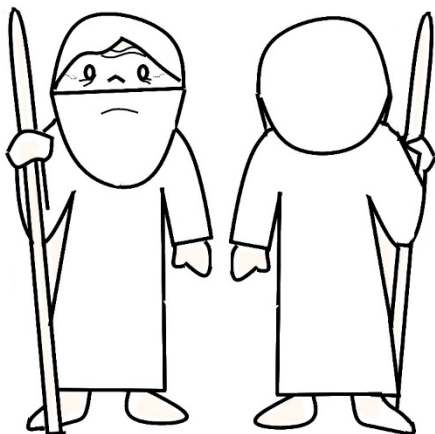
- Fold the small tabs at the bottom of the palm trees. Glue them on different places of the land piece on Main Page.
- Check to make sure the mountain pieces are dry and slide the slits together, then adjust them so that the mountain stands.
- Lay the mountain flat and place a small amount of repositionable glue on the bottom of the mountain only on one side.
- Let it dry for 1 minute.
- Glue the Hebrew word Katan at the top left corner and the word Gadol on the right side of the land piece.
- To set up your page, stand the mountain up.
- Place Mosheh and Yehoshua on the mountain. The repositionable glue will allow you to place them in different places on the mountain to help tell the story.
- Place the mountain on the right bottom section so that the men are looking down at the land.

This is a visual of the event when Mosheh was able to see the land but NOT go into it, and also when he passed on the leadership to Yehoshua and Mosheh stayed on the mountain as Yehoshua went back down by himself.

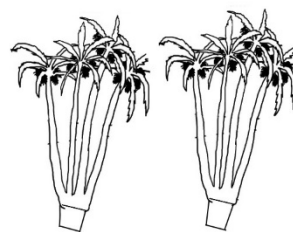
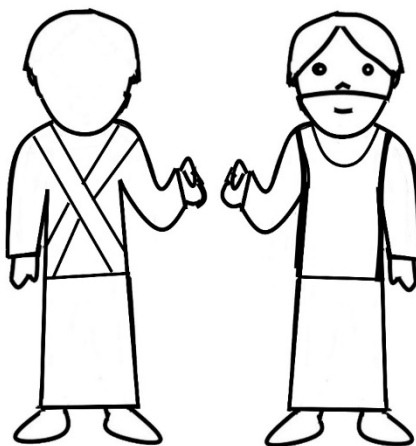




Mosheh
