Notebook Page Instructions Price for Rebellion Numbers 16

Materials:

- card stock (2-white) or 1 white and 1 light color for Main Page
- Optional: brown card stock (for ground)
- Coloring pencils, crayons or markers
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Tacky glue or hot glue
- Brads (paper fasteners) (5)
- Clear cellophane paper
- Seed beads or other black things to represent ashes
- Ribbon or string - gold
- Small rubber band
- Dimensional paint - bronze
- Optional: craft knife and cutting mat
- Pen
- Notebook Template A

Parent/Teacher preparation:

- Print Notebook Template A on white card stock.

Instructions for the notebook page:

- Color everything on Notebook Template A. If using brown card stock for the ground, don't color the ground pieces.
- Cut all the pieces out.
- If using white card stock for the ground, color the 2 pieces in browns and greens.
- If using brown card stock, then trace the white pieces on the brown card stock and cut them out.
- Cut the slits in the center of the ground pieces. A craft knife will make this easier.
- Take the ground pieces and align the flat edges with the bottom of the Main Page.



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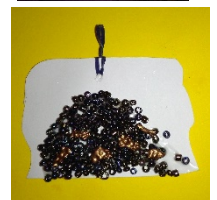
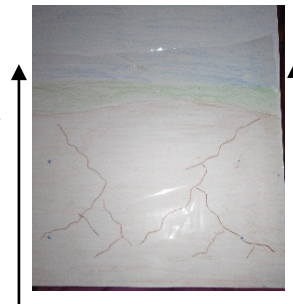
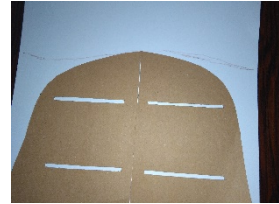
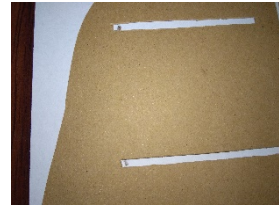
Notebook Page - page 2:

Instructions for the notebook page:

- Using a pen, mark dots through the slits on the ends closest to the edges of the paper. There will be 4 marks. This will be for poking holes later.
- While the ground is still lined up, mark a line, not necessarily straight, where the tops of the ground pieces end.
- From this line to the bottom of the Main Page, color it brown to all edges of the paper to represent the ground.
- Make lines to represent the ground breaking up.
- Just above the line, color a small section green to represent land.
- Above the land, color the rest of the page blue.
- Take the clear cellophane and measure and cut a piece about $7\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " (19 cm x 21 $\frac{1}{2}$ cm).
- To create a pocket with the cellophane, use a glue stick and apply glue to the bottom edge of the Main Page, as well as the right and left sides $7\frac{1}{2}$ " (19 cm) from the bottom of the page.
- Place cellophane on the bottom edge of the page, lining up the side edges, and press to glue in place.
- Poke holes through the cellophane and the page at the dots previously marked. Set aside.

Assembling the pieces-(note: the next steps may be done earlier in the process)

- Poke a hole at the center top of the group of men.
- Insert the small rubber band through the hole and loop it on itself to make a hanger.
- Using dimensional paint, make a few lines on the hands of some of the men to represent the fire holders. Set aside to dry.
- Turn the cloud right side down and glue a few pieces of gold ribbon or string to represent fire. Set aside to dry.
- Once the dimensional paint is dry on the men, turn the piece right side down and glue the seed beads to represent ashes on the back of the piece.
- Once the beads are dry, add some dots of dimensional paint throughout to represent the fire holders in the ashes and set aside to dry.

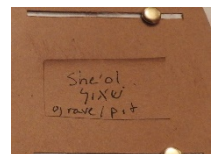
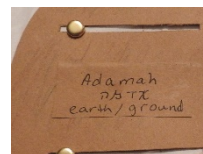
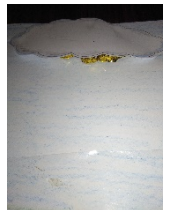
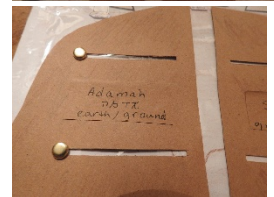
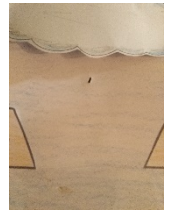
Instructions for the notebook page cont'd:

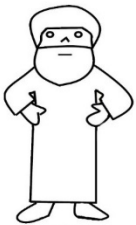
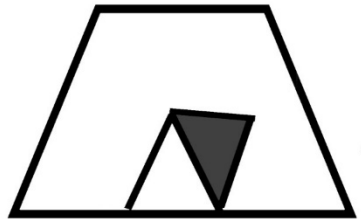
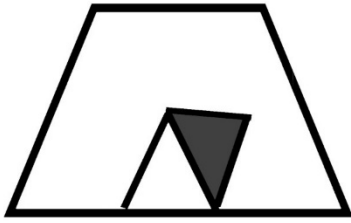
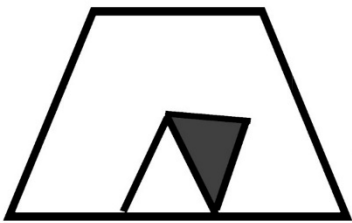
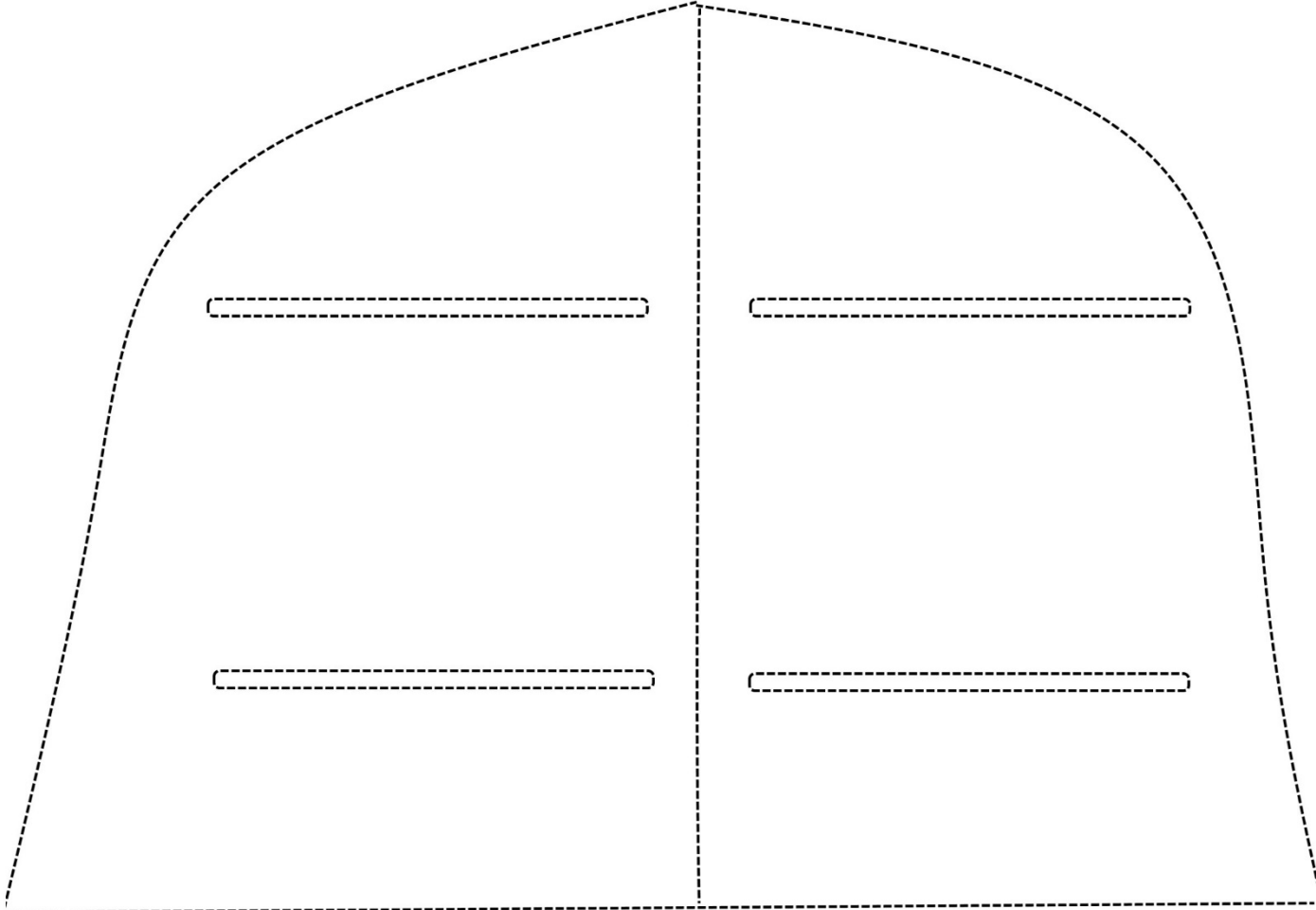
Assembling the page:

- Check that the ribbons or strings on the cloud are dry.
- Center the cloud on the top of the Main Page and glue it in place at opposite sides.
- Poke a hole just under the cloud on the Main Page.
- Push the brad through the rubber band hanger on the 250 leaders and through the hole you just made. Open the legs of the brad in back to fasten.
- Take 2 of the tents and glue them above the cellophane.
- Carefully place the 3 tents just under the cellophane above the ground pieces.
- Place Qorah (Qehathite), Dathan and Abiram (Re'ubenite) in front of their 3 tents.
- Take a brad and push it through the top slit on a ground piece and through the top hole on the corresponding side. Open the brad at the back.
- Repeat the process for the bottom slit and bottom hole on the same ground piece.
- Repeat steps for the second ground piece.
- Push the strings or ribbons inside the cloud to hide them.
- Cut 2 small rectangles either out of the brown or white card stock you used, for the Hebrew words for this week. Write them on the rectangles as follows:
 - 1) "Adamah" 2) "אדמה" 3) "earth/ground"
 - 1) "She'ol" 2) "שאול" 3) "grave/pit"
- Glue a word on each of the ground pieces.

The page is finished. This is a visual representation of the event that took place when Qorah, Dathan, Abiram and 250 leaders of the congregation came up against Mosheh, Aharon and Yahweh.

They can bring down the 'fire' from the cloud. Flip the men so that it shows them being 'consumed'. The ground pieces can slide apart to represent the ground opening up and then the 3 tents and the men go down into She'ol.





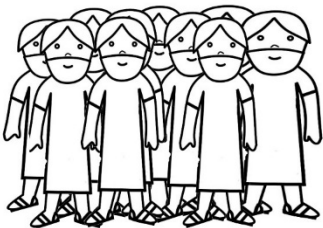
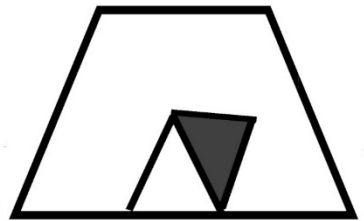
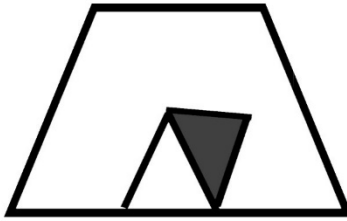
Gehathite
