

# PRECIOUS POSSESSIONS

## Notebook Page Instructions Clearing out the Land Numbers 33:51-52

### Materials:

- Card stock - any color (2)
- Coloring pencils, crayons or markers
- Glue
- Brads (paper fasteners)
- Dimensional paint - gold and/or silver
- Dimensional paint - blue
- Toothpicks
- Optional: scrap of black card stock (for inhabitants)
- Pen
- Notebook Templates - Main Page and Template B

### Parent/Teacher preparation:

- Print all templates on card stock.

### Instructions for the notebook page:

#### Main Page

- Color the large land mass green.
- Color the divided pieces of land different colors. This represents the tribes who already received their inheritance.
- If using blue dimensional paint, then paint the water section, including the line between the 2 water sections to represent the Yarden River. Set it aside to dry.

#### Craft Template B

- Color the stones representing the engraved stones on Craft Template A.
- If decorating them with gold or silver dimensional paint, then separate them from the rest of the card stock and decorate the pieces. Set them aside to dry.
- Color the Yisra'elites on Craft Template B.
- Using a black marker, color the inhabitants on Template B, or you can cut them out as a group and use them to trace onto black card stock.
- Cut out all the items on Craft Template B.
- Poke a hole through the 'x' on the Yisra'elites and the engraved stones. Check to make sure stones are dry if dimensional paint was used.

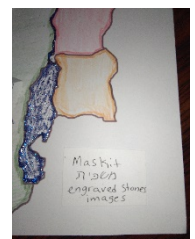
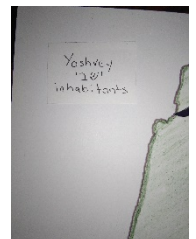

Notebook Page - page 2:

Instructions for the notebook page:

*Assembling the parts*

- Assemble the people by putting a brad through 1 arm, the body and then the other arm (either arm can be in the front). Open the brad to hold in place.
- Repeat the process for the rest of the Yisra'elites.
- Assemble the carved stones by putting a brad through the tip of the largest engraved stone and then through the hole in the medium engraved stone. Open brad to hold in place.
- Push another brad through the smallest section then through the other hole on the largest stone. Open the brad to hold it in place.
- Cut or break the tips off the toothpicks.
- Glue a toothpick to the hand of each of the Yisra'elites.
- Cut 5 small strips from your scraps about 4" (10 cm) long and  $\frac{1}{4}$ " ( $\frac{3}{4}$  cm) wide. Cut 2 strips 3" ( $6\frac{1}{2}$  cm) long and  $\frac{3}{4}$ " (2 cm) wide.
- Fold a section about  $\frac{1}{2}$ " ( $1\frac{1}{4}$  cm) long on 1-4" (10 cm) strip. Then fold it about 1" ( $2\frac{1}{2}$  cm) to  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " ( $3\frac{3}{4}$  cm) from where you folded last piece.
- Repeat the strip folding for the rest of the strips.
- Glue the  $\frac{1}{2}$ " ( $1\frac{1}{4}$  cm) section to the back of an Yisra'elite's leg, lining up the fold with the bottom of the foot.
- Repeat the steps above for all the Yisra'elites.
- Glue the last 4" (10 cm) strip to the back of the inhabitants.
- Glue the 2-3" ( $6\frac{1}{2}$  cm) strips to the backs of the engraved stones.
- Cut 2 small rectangles for the Hebrew words.
- Write the Hebrew words:
  - 1) "Yoshvey" 2) "יֹשְׁבֵי" 3) "Inhabitants"
  - 1) "Maskit" 2) "מַשְׁכִּית" 3) "Engraved stones/images"

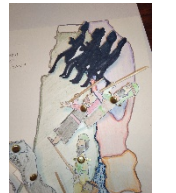

**Instructions for the notebook page cont'd:**

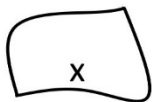
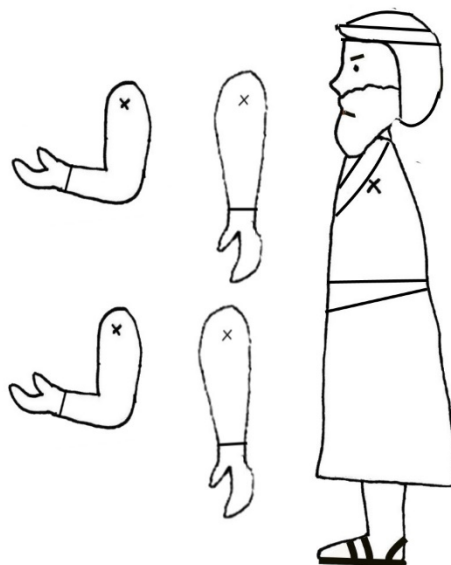
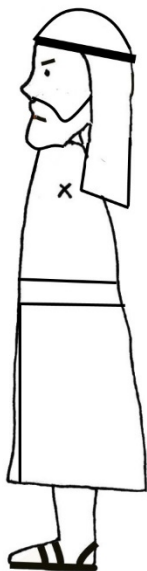
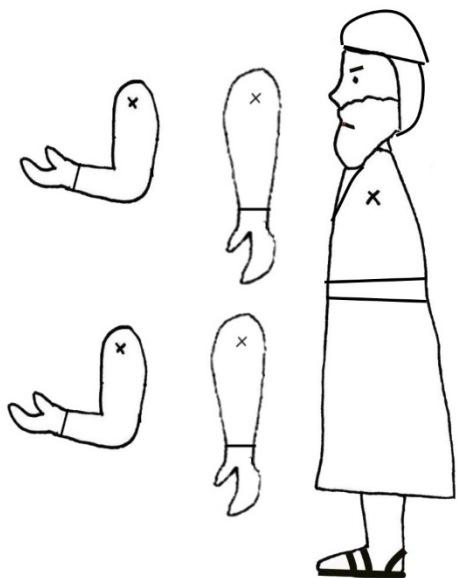
*Assembling the page*

- Work each strip folding it 2 more times so that it will hold up each character on the page. Then glue the end to the back of the character.
- Glue the 1" ( $2\frac{1}{2}$  cm) to  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " ( $3\frac{3}{4}$  cm) folded section of each strip to the map in the following order:
  - the engraved stones to the left bottom part of the map
  - 2 of the Yisra'elites in front of the engraved stones
  - the other Yisra'elites towards the center of the map, staying on the large section
  - the inhabitants towards the top of the map
  - the word for inhabitants on the left top side of the page
  - the word for engraved stones to the bottom right of the page

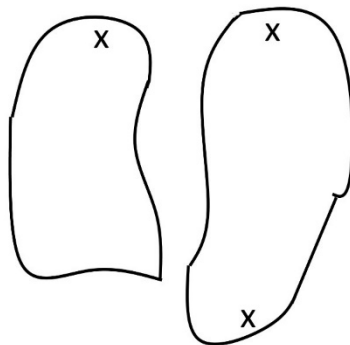
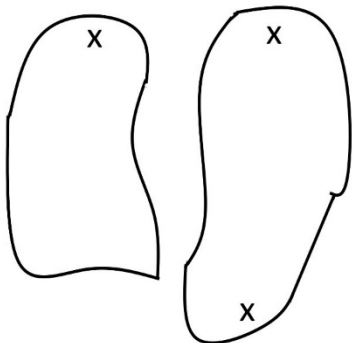
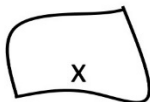
This is a representation of what Yahweh wanted the Yisra'elites to do once they entered the land.
