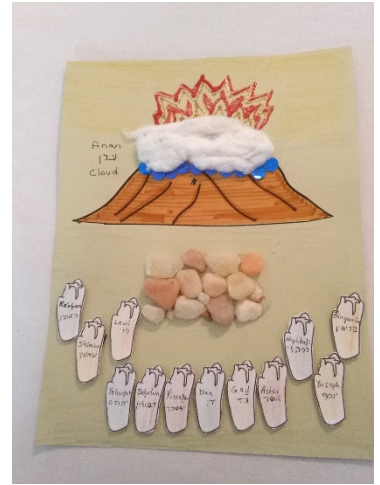
## Notebook Page Instructions

Mt. Sinai

Exodus 24:4, 10, 15-18

### Materials:

- Card stock - light color & white
- Card stock
- Coloring pencils crayons or markers
- Scissors
- Glue
- Hot glue
- Dimensional paint - gold, red, orange and/or yellow
- Cotton balls or white felt
- Sequins, gems or dimensional glue - blue
- Stones, foam, or scraps of construction paper or card stock
- Scraps of foam - any color
- Pen

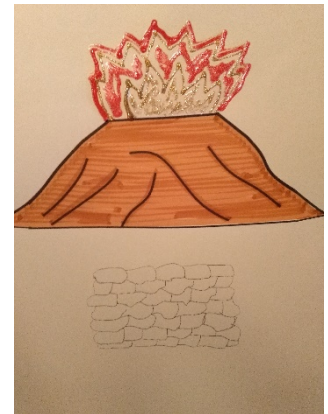
### Parent/Teacher preparation:

- Print Main Page on light colored card stock.
- Print Template B on white card stock.

### Instructions for the notebook page:

#### Creating the Main Page background:

- Color the mountain on the Main Page. Color the sky and land on this page. The sky could be in colors that indicate the glowing from the fire.
- Draw flames coming from the mountain using the dimensional paint. The flames can go from the top of the mountain as high as desired.
- If using blue dimensional paint for sapphire representation, then do this part as well on the mountain. This should be about  $\frac{1}{2}$ " ( $1\frac{1}{4}$  cm) to  $\frac{3}{4}$ " (2 cm) below the top of the mountain. Set it aside to dry.



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## Notebook Page - page 2:

### Instructions for the notebook page cont'd:

#### Standing Columns:

- Color the standing columns on Template B using earthy tones.
- Pull out the 'Ya'aqob's Sons in Hebrew' flashcards and write a name on each column. They can write it in English, Hebrew or both.
- Cut all the columns out.
- Cut small pieces of the foam scrap to attach to the back of each column. It does not need to be the same size as the column, but just large enough so that it is not seen. The foam scraps will be used to glue them to the Main Page when we get to that point.

#### Assembling the page:

- Check to make sure the dimensional paint on the Main Page is dry. If so, begin assembling the page.
- Write the Hebrew word for the week next to the mountain top, next to where the cloud will be attached:

1) "Anan" 2) "ענן" 3) "Cloud"

- Take a cotton ball or a piece of white felt to make a cloud to cover the top of the mountain. If using dimensional paint for the sapphire part, make sure the cloud doesn't cover it up. Glue the cloud in place.
- If not using dimensional paint, glue the sequins or gems right under the cloud. Put a long line of them from one edge of the mountain to the other.

#### Building the altar:

- If using foam or paper, cut out several stone shapes.
- If using stones then just start gluing them in place right over the altar on the Main Page. It is not necessary to follow the pattern on the picture, just cover it up. Be sure to color the altar.
- Finally, glue the columns in place. There is no specific pattern on how they should be placed, so just place them so that they all fit neatly. Put some glue on the back of the foam piece and glue the columns in place.

Now that all the pieces are in place, the page is finished showing the types of things seen at Mt. Sinai when Yahweh gave the commandments.
