

PRECIOUS POSSESSIONS

Craft Instructions

A Turning Heart
Deuteronomy 29:18

Materials:

- Felt square - red & black
- Marker
- Scissors
- Dimensional paint - green, yellow, brown, blue or gold and silver
- Hot glue
- Craft Template A

Parent/Teacher preparation:

- Print Craft Template A on regular paper

Instructions for the craft:

- Cut out the heart on Craft Template A.
- Using the heart template, trace the shape on the red felt.
- Place the red felt on top of the black felt and cut both pieces at the same time. Separate the 2 heart pieces.
- Using dimensional paint, draw a wormwood plant (see image provided), thorny roots or items representing idols on the black heart.
- Wait for the paint to dry. Once dried, hot glue the red heart over the black heart hiding the pictures drawn on the black heart.
- Leave the tip of the heart and the corner at the top opened to be able to insert scissors for cutting.
- Stick the scissors through one of the openings on the red part of the heart. Cut all the way to the other end. Check to make sure glued sections didn't pull apart.
- Flip the heart so that the black heart shows with the pictures you drew.
- Turn the red part back to the front covering the black heart and the picture.
- Flatten the heart and write the word "Torah" or "Yahweh" with blue, gold or silver so that it goes across the heart opening. Let the paint dry.

This is a visual of the verse that reminds the child of Yisra'el not to turn their hearts away from Yahweh and towards idols.

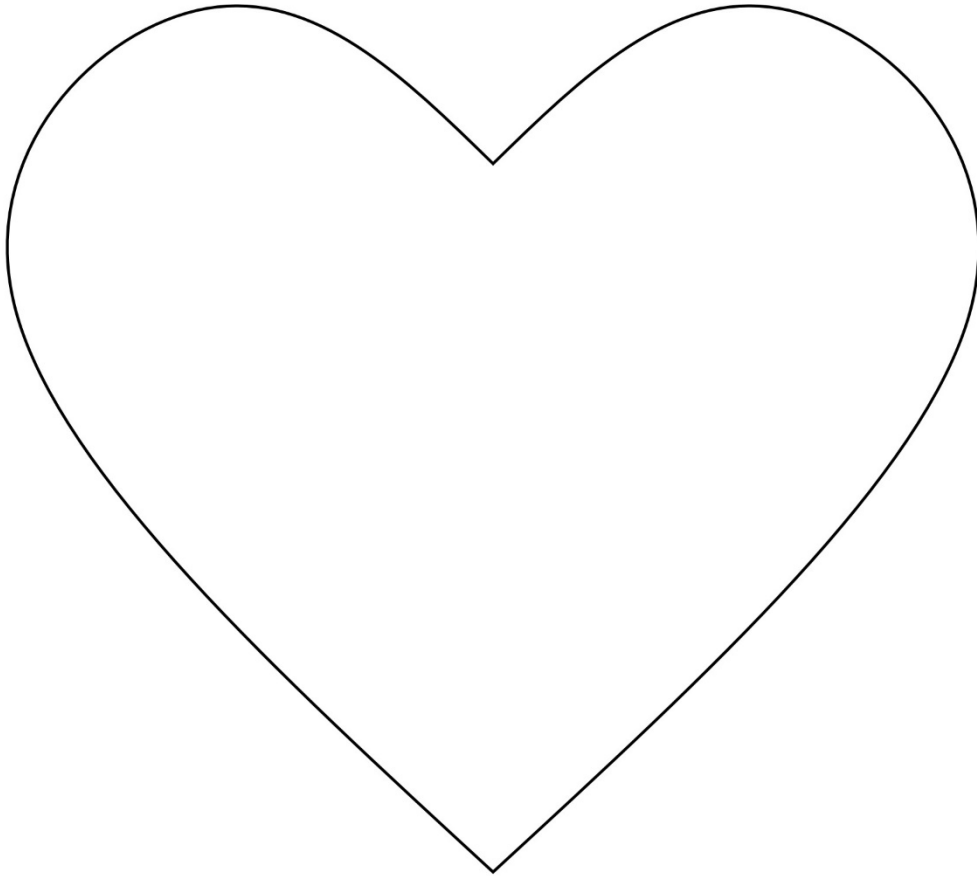


Image of wormwood provided as a visual reference to draw the plant
