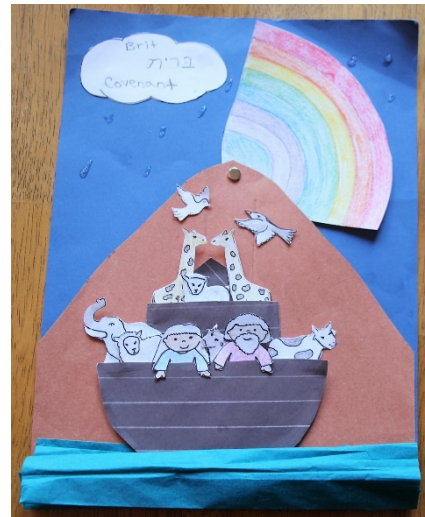


# PRECIOUS POSSESSIONS

## Notebook Page Instructions The Flood Genesis 6:14 - 8:4

### Materials:

- Card stock - blue and white
- Copy paper
- Construction paper or other light weight paper - light brown
- Construction paper or scrapbook paper - dark brown
- Optional: cardboard from an cereal box or similar weight
- Tissue paper - blue, cut to 8½" (21 ½ cm) x 11" (28 cm)
- Options for rain drops: clear glitter, blue or white dimensional paint, puffy paint, finger paint or markers
- Coloring pencils, crayons or markers
- Pen
- Brad (paper fastener)
- White glue and hot glue or *Tacky Glue*
- Scissors
- Notebook Templates: A & B



### Parent/Teacher preparation:

- Print Notebook Template A on copy paper or card stock for tracing.
- Print Notebook Template B on white card stock.

### Instructions for the notebook page:

- Trace the mountain (A4) from Notebook Template A on the light brown construction paper and cut it out.
- Overlay the template (A4) over the brown mountain shape. Cut along the 2 dotted lines, careful to stop where each dotted line ends.
- Trace and cut out the ark parts (A1, A2 and A3) from Notebook Template A onto the dark brown paper. There will be a bottom boat shape (A1), a small house shape (A2) and a rectangle (A3).
- Cut the complete ark (B1) and the thin rectangle (B3) from Notebook Template B.
- The complete ark template needs to be sturdy. Either trace both of these pieces onto the cardboard for a sturdier piece, or use it as is. The ark will be glued to this base.

Notebook Page - page 2:

## Instructions for the notebook page cont'd:

- Glue the ark parts (A1, A2 and A3) onto the complete ark in the following order to create pockets in which to put the animals. Note: the ark parts are slightly larger than completed ark. Trim it down after gluing, but ensure the pockets are loose enough to put characters in.
  - Glue the dark brown house shape (A2) at the sides and bottom. Do NOT put glue on the top (roof) area so that a pocket is created at the top. Align the top to the complete ark base and set the piece down.
  - Glue the sides and bottom of the dark brown rectangle (A3) and set it down on ark. Do NOT put glue on the top so that a pocket is created. Again, align the top with the edge then set it down.
  - Glue the dark brown bottom boat shape (A1) around the sides and bottom. This one will be a little difficult, so it may need to be trimmed before it is glued. Ensure that it covers the base completely.
- Decorate the ark to make it look like wood with lines, etc.
- Glue the small rectangle piece (B3) to the back bottom of the ark, but only glue the ends leaving the center open, so that a piece of paper will slide through it. We recommend using hot glue or *Tacky Glue* for quicker drying.

**Notebook Page - page 3:**

## **Instructions for the notebook page cont'd:**

- A parent or teacher may want/need to do this next part. Slide the ark onto the center piece of the mountain via the piece glued to the back of the ark.
  - Slide the ark to the top and carefully glue the bottom of the mountain to the bottom of the blue card stock. This will seal the ark in so it can slide up and down the mountain but won't slide off. Do NOT glue the top part of the mountain to the blue card stock.
- Fold the blue tissue paper into an accordion with folds about  $\frac{1}{2}$ " ( $1\frac{1}{4}$  cm) wide. They do NOT have to be perfect, but make sure it can open and close easily. This is used as water and when attached to the bottom of the ark, it slides up the mountain and the water will rise over the mountain.
- Glue one end of the tissue paper over the mountain bottom on the card stock.
- Slide the ark down and glue the bottom to the other end of the tissue.
  - Optional: glue it to the back side and then glue one fold to the front. The ark should slide up and down the mountain and the tissue accordion open up when the ark goes up and close when the ark comes down.

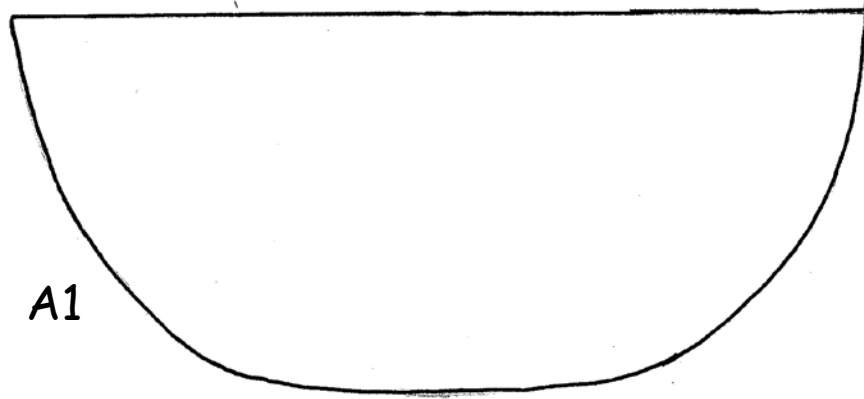

**Notebook Page - page 4:**

**Instructions for the notebook page cont'd:**

- Color Noah and his wife (B2), the animals (B4), and the rainbow (B5) on Notebook Template B.
- Cut out the rainbow (B5) and slide it under the mountain top so that the bottom of the rainbow is aligned with the top of the mountain. The rainbow should be completely hidden.
  - Using the tip of the scissors, punch a hole through all 3 layers just big enough to push a brad through all layers.
  - Put a brad through the hole and open it on the back of the paper. Now the rainbow can come up from the mountain by sliding it from the back of the mountain.
- Cut out the rest of the pieces, animals (B4), Noah and wife (B2). The animals and people will fit in the pockets of the ark. Place the dove and raven in the roof pocket.
- Cut out a cloud shape from white card stock, large enough to write the Hebrew word on it. Write:
  - 1) "Brit"
  - 2) "ברית"
  - 3) "Covenant"
- Finally, using material of choice from the materials list for rain drops, make rain drops in the sky. If using paint, allow time for it to dry.

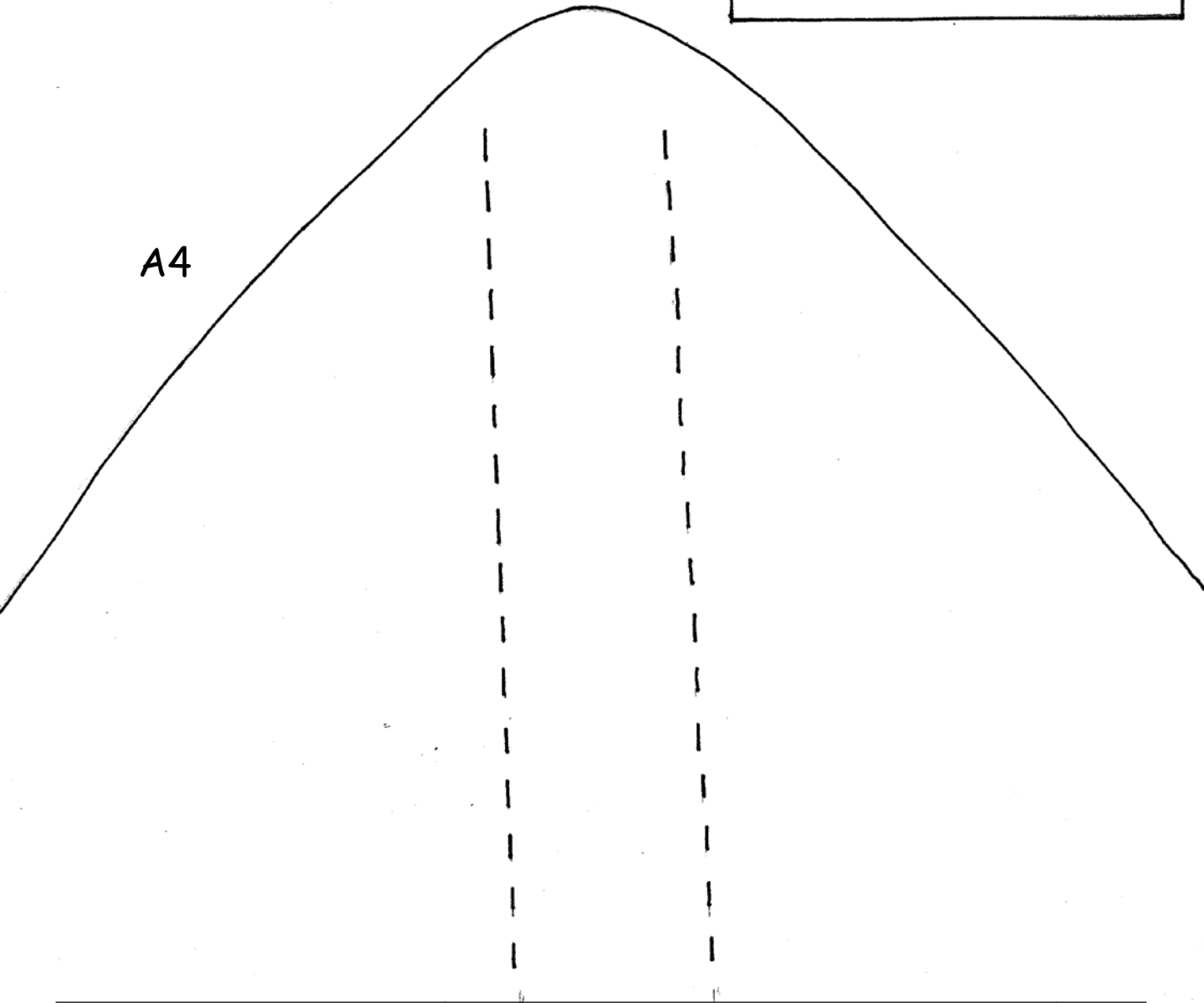
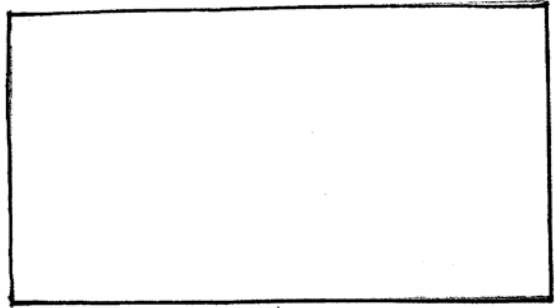
