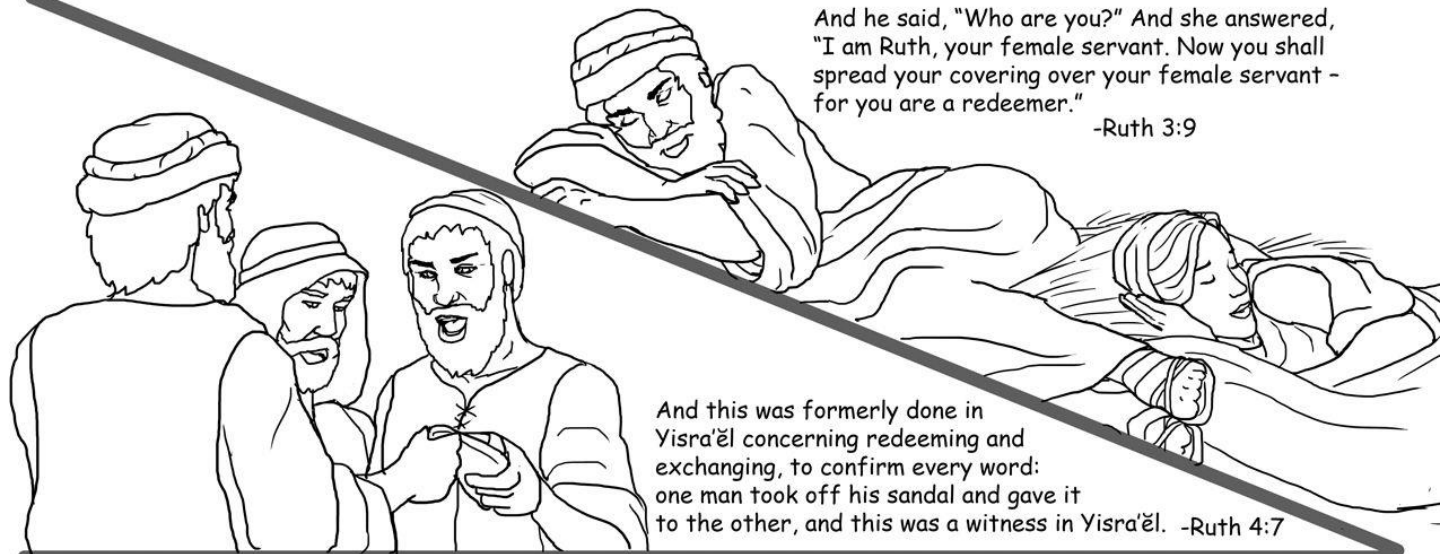


And she left, and went and gleaned in the field after the reapers. As it turned out, she came to the part of the field belonging to Bo'az, the near relative of Elimelek.
