

# PRECIOUS POSSESSIONS

## Craft Instructions Clean and Unclean Animals Leviticus 11

### Materials:

#### General materials:

- Stuffing or filling
- Googly eyes
- Hot glue
- Scissors

#### For the pig:

- Sock - pink
- 2 hole pink button
- Small scrap of pink foam
- Chenille stems - pink (3)
- Wooden buttons (4)

#### For the chick or duck:

- Sock - yellow or orange
- Chenille stem to match the bird (1)
- Craft foam - yellow
- Feathers to match the bird

#### For the turtle:

- Glove - green

### Parent/Teacher preparation:

We will be giving instructions for several animals. With so many clean and unclean animals to choose from, be creative and come up with your own animals.

The instructions we are providing are basic instructions that can be used for many different animals.

- The size of the stuffed animal will depend on the size of socks or glove you use.

For additional clean animals go back to the Vayikra craft and follow the instructions for the cow and sheep.

Craft - page 2:

## Instructions for the craft:

*For the pig:*

- Stuff the pink sock (Note: using fuzzy socks make the stuffed animals softer) to the heel.
- Once stuffed, firmly take the leg of the sock and twist it to secure the stuffing inside.
- Fold the sock over itself and pull it tight.
- Fold the excess, but do NOT twist this time. Just make a band with the sock.
- Next, to create the legs, tuck 1 of the pink chenille stems in one end of the band and glue it in place a little at a time.
- Repeat for the back legs.
- For the tail, take the third pipe cleaner; this can be a scrap of one as you do NOT need the whole stem. Twist it around a pencil to make it look like a spring.
- Cut it in half and glue it to one end of the sock.
- Turn the pig to the other side and glue the button to the center for the nose.
- Glue the eyes in place above the nose.
- With pink craft foam, cut 2 half ovals for the ears.
- Glue the flat ends together to make it crease.
- Glue the ears to the top of the head. Use the eyes as a guide to line up where the ears should go.
- Last, push a bead on the end of each leg and glue them in place for hooves.
- The pig is finished. This is an unclean animal.

*For the duck or the chick:*

- Stuff the sock to the heel.
- Fold the rest of the sock down and cut a small slit close where the stuffing stops.
- Insert the scissors in the hole and then cut half way around.
- Push the cut side in and place the chenille stem on top.

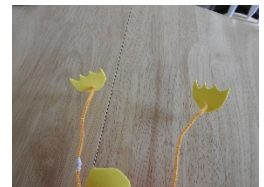

## Craft - page 3:

### Instructions for the craft cont'd:

- Add hot glue, then fold the other side pulling it down over the first fold and sandwiching the chenille stem.
- Hot glue in place.
- Cut the excess sock. Once the opening is glued closed trim the excess sock.
- Glue any places that are still open.
- Another way to do the legs, if you forget to place the chenille stem over the fold, is to cut the chenille in half and insert an end to the opposite sides. Cut a small slit in the fold and push the stem in, then hot glue it in place.
- Take a feather for each side and push one in on each side for a wing.
- Hot glue in place.
- Put a few feathers together and glue the ends together to make the feathers make a little fan.
- Turn the bird body over and hot glue the feather fan in place for the tail.
- For a chick, cut an elongated diamond shape from the foam or for the duck cut an oval shape to form the beak.
  - Fold it in half.
  - Put glue on the fold and push it on the face of the bird.
  - For the duck, glue the corners a little bit so it doesn't stay wide open.
  - Glue eyes on the face.
  - Cut 2 more ovals for the feet, on one end of the oval cut out small half circles for the duck to make webbed feet, and triangles to make the chicken feet.
  - Push the end of the chenille stem that are the legs into a foot and hot glue in place.
- Repeat for the other foot.
- The bird is finished. This is a clean animal.

Craft - page 4:

## Instructions for the craft cont'd:

*For the turtle:*

- Stuff the glove, making sure to stuff the fingers so they are firm.
- Cut a circle from a piece of card stock or light card board about the size of the palm of the glove you are using.
- Put it inside the palm of the glove; this will be the belly of the turtle.
- Make sure the rest of the hand is now stuffed so that it makes a hump. The card board will help to keep it from having a hump at the bottom (belly).
- Once the glove is stuffed, glue the opening shut so that it makes a tail. Glue it closed straight and then fold inward and glue the 2 corners closed.
- Take the 2 outer fingers of the glove, one on each side, and pull them backwards towards the tail. Hot glue each finger against the body of the turtle so they stay back for the back legs.
- Add eyes to the middle finger to make the face.
- The turtle is finished. This is an unclean animal.
