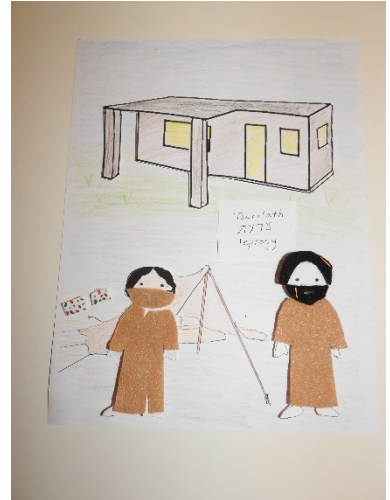


# PRECIOUS POSSESSIONS

## Notebook Page Instructions Tsara'ath on Skin, Head, Beard and House Leviticus 13-14

### Materials:

- Card stock - white (2)
- Coloring pencils or crayons
- Markers
- Glue
- Repositionable glue
- Scissors
- Hook and loop dots or self-stick *Velcro*
- Fabric or scraps of brown felt
- Scraps of black felt
- Scraps of white craft foam
- Yellow paint or a yellow string
- Toothpick (if using paint)
- Notebook Templates: Main Page and B



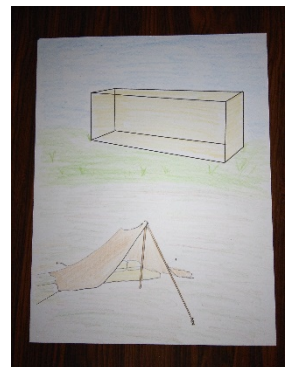
Note: There will be no video for this week's Notebook Page.

### Parent/Teacher preparation:

- Print the Main Page and the Notebook Template B on white card stock.

### Instructions for the notebook page:

- Color both men, the house front and the furniture on Notebook Template B.
- Cut all pieces out.
- Set aside.
- The tunic, face cloth, hair and beard will be used as templates. If you don't have the felt or fabric pieces, use what is printed on the card stock. If choosing this option, either print 2 tunics or trace and cut a second tunic onto a scrap piece of card stock.
- Color and decorate the Main Page template so that the top half (the inside of the house) looks much brighter than the lower half of the page. The division is to show that the tent is outside of the camp. We simply colored the top half to look like green grass and the bottom half more like a desert.



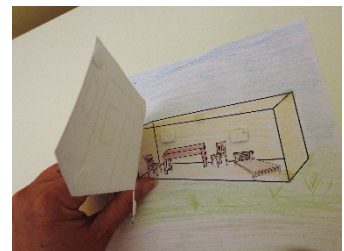
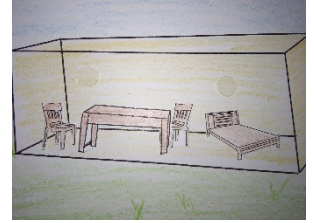

**Notebook Page - page 2:**

**Instructions for the notebook page:**

*For the unclean house:*

- Take the furniture pieces and put some repositionable glue on the back of all the pieces.
- Set aside for the glue to dry.
- Once dry, the furniture will be able to be removed from the house.
- Using the white foam, cut 4 or more small rectangles. If doing more than 4, make sure to do an even number. These pieces will represent the infected stones that were removed from the house as well as the new stones to replace the infected ones.
- Place a piece of the loop side on each of the foam pieces.
- Color some dots on the front of 2 of the stones (or half the number you chose to create) using a green and a red marker. We did 2.
- Place some hook pieces on the walls of the house. The number should equal half the number of stones you created. We did 2.
- Place some hook pieces somewhere on the bottom half of the page, in the area we are using to represent the unclean. We placed them near the tent.
- Now put the stones with the red and green dots on the bottom of the page and the good stones on the house walls.
- Place some loop pieces at various places on the back of the house front.
- Place some hook pieces on the inside of the house on the Main Page to correspond with the loop pieces so that the house front can cover the inside of the house.
- Align the house front so that the house inside is covered by the house front. When removing the house front, be careful to hold the page and pull gently so as not to rip the hook pieces or tear the paper.

**Notebook Page - page 3:**

**Instructions for the notebook page cont'd:**

*For the unclean people:*

- Take the man that has a permanent beard and put red spots on him to represent the leprosy.
- Trace a tunic and the face cloth on the fabric or scraps of brown felt.
- Cut them out.
- Using scissors, cut a slit at the top and bottom of the tunic to represent it being torn.
- Put some repositionable glue on the backs of both pieces and set aside to dry.
- Put some loop pieces on the back of the men.
- Place corresponding pieces of hook on the paper on the bottom of the page so this man can be outside the camp.
- Take the hair and beard and use them as templates to cut hair and beard from black felt. Use the card stock pieces as they are if desired.
- Put some repositionable glue on the back of the beard and hair.
- Set them aside to dry.
- Once dry, draw a mouth on the beard piece.
- Paint a yellow line on the beard and hair using a toothpick. If using string instead of painting, glue a tiny piece on the beard and another one on the hair.
- Trace a tunic for this man just as above but do not cut the tunic to show tearing.
- Put repositionable glue on the back of the tunic and set aside to dry.
- Assemble the man. His beard can be removed to show he has shaved.
- Cut a rectangle out of the scraps from Notebook Template B; large enough to write the Hebrew word for this week:  
1) "Tsara'ath" 2) "צרעת" 3) "Leprosy"
- Glue the rectangle between the house and the area outside the camp.
